As a private freestanding non-profit, we do not receive governmental or public funds for operations. Our primary source of operations revenue comes from client service fees. We depend upon donations in order to provide care to individuals who are uninsured or lack access to financial resources.

For the clients protection, our staff are trained, supervised, bonded and insured. We provide staff and clients with on-call access for help with sudden illness or emergency situations. All staff is required to attend continuing education and must maintain licenses and certifications in accordance with governing laws.
